



CALL FOR PERSONS TO SERVE ON THE MSUNDUZI MUNICIPAL PLANNING TRIBUNAL

In terms of the Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act, Act 16 of 2013, the Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites nominations from members of the public to be appointed to the Municipal Planning Tribunal comprising of five persons who hold qualifications as Professional Town and Regional Planners, Land Surveyors, Attorneys or Advocates and Engineers. The period of office of members will be twenty four months (two years) calculated from the date of appointment of such members by the Msunduzi Municipality.

Nominees must be persons with leadership qualities and in terms of Section 36(1) of the Act such persons must have knowledge and experience of Spatial Planning, Land Use Management and Land Use Development or the law thereto.

Nominations must reach the Msunduzi Municipality by no later than 08 July 2016. Each nomination must be in writing and must contain the following information:

- a) The name and address of the nominator, who must be a natural person. Please note that a person may nominate himself or herself;
- b) The name, address and identity number of the nominee;
- c) Motivation by the nominator for the appointment of the nominee to the Planning Tribunal;
- d) A curriculum vitae that will enable the Municipality to determine whether the nominee has sufficient knowledge and experience to perform the required functions;
- e) Certified copies of qualifications and registration certificates indicating registration with the relevant professional body or voluntary association.

Please note that failure to comply with the above requirements may result in the disqualification of the nominee.
