PROVISION OF AD-HOC PROFESSIONAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO BE LISTED ONTO THE MSUNDUZI MUNICIPALITY'S SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT DATABASE FOR PROJECTS EXCEEDING ONE MILLION RAND (>R1,000,000.00)

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Service Providers for the Provision of Ad-Hoc Professional Planning and Development Services to be listed onto the Msunduzi Municipality's Supply Chain Management Database for projects exceeding one million rand (>R1,000,000.00) on an "as and when required" basis for a period of three years.

The scope of work which the panel of Service Providers will engage with, will include but not be limited to the following:-

A non - refundable tender fee in the amount of **R401.28 (including VAT) per document** shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with "**Contract No. SCM 102 of 14/15: Provision of Ad-Hoc Professional Planning and Development Services**" must be placed in the Tender Box, located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Thursday, 25 June 2015**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of the tender.

Tender Evaluation Criteria: The tenders shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-
