CONTRACT No. SCM 10 OF 15/16

CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW 6.0ML RESERVOIR AT EPAYIPHANI AND APPROXIMATELY 1.10KM RETICULATION MAINS IN WARD 1

The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably qualified and experienced Contractors for the construction of a reinforced concrete 6.0Mℓ circular reservoir and approximately 1.10km associated reticulation mains in Ward 1, Pietermaritzburg.

Only Contractors registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) with a Contractor Grading of 7CE, or higher, shall be eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **12h00 on Friday, 04 September 2015**. A non - refundable tender fee in the amount **R707.94 (including VAT) per document** shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A compulsory Tender Clarification Meeting will be held prompt at **10h30, on Tuesday 15 September 2015**, in the **Water and Sanitation Boardroom, 3rd Floor, Professor Nyembezi Centre, 341 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg**. Only one Tender Clarification Meeting will be held. **Note: Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time above will be disqualified.**

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with “**Contract No. SCM 10 of 15/16: Construction of a New 6.0Mℓ Reservoir at Ephayiphani and Approximately 1.10km Reticulation Mains in Ward 1**” must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Monday, 28 September 2015**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-

3	Locality of Company	20 Points
