**Re – Gravelling:** Re – gravelling and betterment of Main and District Roads on the current network.

**EPWP** – Special funding for Road Maintenance

- **MR 402 (km0-7):** Design sage
- **MR 412:** - In Progress.
- **DR 1122:** In Progress 0-3km Completing ancillary works
- **DR 1126:** Design
- **MR 139-2:** In progress rehab and safety improvements from XWays to Sweetwaters – R 54 000 000.00
- **DR 1124 (km0-2):** Rehabilitation (Patch & overlay)

# Challenges we face:

- Shortage of funding.
- Supervision of projects.
- Skills Shortage
- Staff shortages – supervision and operators.
- Suitable available quarry material.
- Shortage of technical skills.
- Roads built by Municipalities have not been done to DoT standards in some instances.

# CONCLUSION

- There are numerous gravel and surfaced roads that are in poor condition and will be a challenge in maintaining them in the next few years.
- Certain gravel roads will be come impassable when it rains – however we will undertake to maintain them with the current resources we have.
- In order to ensure there is no duplication of projects Local Municipalities need to liaise closely with the Department of Transport staff in future projects.
