Due to COVID 19, they had to retrench a couple number of employees leaving them with only 6 workers. But none the less, they are a very dedicated company which looks forward expand.





VEXILA

On the 21st of July 2023, the Business Development team visited one of the company at Willowton, **Vexila**. The company was established 52 years ago as Hardware Assemblies. The company manufactures electrical infrastructure products which they test it themselves after manufacturing. These products are exported to different international countries, like Australia and countries in Europe. Their biggest supplier is Eskom. The biggest downfall they encountered was during Covid-19, where international exporting was banned however, they have recovered. Vexila is currently having 262 employees and anticipates to work with other people and companies. They sometimes cater for neighboring schools as part of their Corporate Social Investment (CSI).
