NAMING AND RENAMING OF STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES

The Msunduzi municipality hereby invites all persons and organisation having an interest in the proposal regarding the naming and renaming of streets in the areas of Vudlindlela and Edendale wards 1,2,3,4,5 and 10,11,12,20,21,22,and 23. Submit your motivated proposal based on the policy and criteria adopted by the council regarding the naming and renaming of streets, community halls, parks and public places.

Process by which naming and renaming shall take place;

- (a) All matters concerning the naming of new streets vest in the Municipality and must be submitted in writing to the Municipality.
- (b) Any person, community or organisation within the boundaries of the City of Pietermaritzburg is entitled to propose new names. These names must be forwarded to the Councillor of the ward in order to add the naming as an item on the Ward Committee meeting.
- (c) The Municipality may initiate the process of naming of streets.

How to apply

Any application for a new street names must include at least the following:

- Details the applicant (names, postal address and contact details)
- Sufficient information about the name (origin, historical background, meaning, language and pronunciation)
- Motivating memorandum
- If a person's name is proposed, consent from the person (if he/she is still alive) or the family (if the person is deceased) should be included in the motivating memorandum

The proposal of new street names, remaining of pre-named streets and public places can be emailed to streetnaming@msunduzi.gov.za or call 033 392 2387. Submissions can also be made at the relevant ward councillors offices not later than the 8th of January 2021.
