EXPANDING PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAMME

- EPWP is a government programme aimed at eradicating poverty, inequality and unemployment. It seeks in the main to provide work opportunities for unskilled people. It is geared towards people learning new skills to enable them to enter sustainable employment and even set up their own business. EPWP aside from being one of the largest public job programme in the world is one of the most important interventions that democratic government has introduce to create access to job opportunities and advance radical socio economic transformation. The department is responsible for the central coordination of all EPWP interventions in the province.

Selected Department Programmes and interventions CONT.

YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

- The National Youth Services focuses on the maintenance of Government facilities. The targeted group are engaged in formal and accredited programmes consisting of four months of theory and eight months practical on construction sites. The programme enhances skills and encourages youth to establish their own construction companies. The department has hosted successful youth and Women in Construction summits to give special attention to radical socio-economic transformation and growing opportunities for this segment of our population through additional instruments like Eyesizwe Contractor Development Programme and Operation vula. Similarly the procurement Indaba also paid special attention to empowerment of young people.

KZN INTERGRATED GREENING PROGRAMME

- The KZN intergrated greening Programme focuses on greening activities such as growing and planting indigiounous and edible plants, collecting recyclable waste, restoring community forest assets, trading bicycles, water tank solar energy devices. Since its launch, tens of thousands of trees have been planted and work opportunities have been created around the Province. It seeks to improve quality of life by providing positive work opportunities that contribute to envitomenal restiration and protection. The programme is important in the context of drought facing the country as well as food security considerations.

IZANDLA ZIYAGEZANA PROGRAMME

- This programme is aimed at poverty alleviation and job creation through manual clearance of vacant provincial land using labour intensive methods. BURSARY AND INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME

- The department continues to provide financial support to deserving students in the scarce skills disciplines in Built Engineering. Architecture, Quantity Surveying. Engineering, Real Estate and Construction Project Management. The bursary Programme seeks to create a pool of skilled potential future employees in the areas identified. As critical to the Department also res that graduating bursary recipients are provided practical work experience and opportunities to develop their careers. In an effort to address scarce skills, the Department has intensified the recruitment of interns. The programme aims to expose young people with to real work situations that will ultimately enable them to acquire skills and registration with relevant professional bodies. Internship and bursaries are advertised in the media and on website of government departments.
