The Validity period shall hold firm for ninety (90) days commencing from closing date of the quotation.

Tender Adjudication & Evaluation Criteria will be implemented in accordance with the Msunduzi Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy (incorporating Preferential Procurement) on the **80/20-point** system. Adjudication criteria will be as per the tender document, the allocation of points will be in line with **specific goals** as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022 pertaining to the **Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act**, Act No. 5 of 2000.
