We have developed and grown the business over this period. In addition to the Petrol Station a fast food chicken outlet (Mochachos) has been added, as well as a community playground where access is free. This provides a clean, safe and positive social environment for all right at the entrance to the Northern suburbs.

This establishment currently provides employment to more than 100 employees.

We welcome the Bombay Road extension, however we Object to the Plan Proposal (Contract No.SCM 66(R) of 14/15) as there are issues that will lead to the "death" of this business ie. vehicular access to the site.

We also like to place on record that this road extension impacts us the most as we are at the intersection and the viability of our business is dependent on ease of traffic flow in and out of the site.

- When driving on Chota Motala Road from the suburbs to the city, vehicles are totally restricted from driving into the site.
- Vehicles driving on Chota Motala Road from the city to the suburbs will have no access to the site.
- No access from the major arterial Road i.e. Chota Motala Road. This has been our only entrance for the past 16 years and our target market comes from this direction.

We respectfully urge you to please consult with us on suggesting a way forward to alleviate the issue as we have positive insight that will make this proposal work.

The current proposal will lead to the death knell of the business and the loss of at least a 100 jobs.
