A compulsory Tender Briefing meeting will be held at 10h30 prompt on Friday, 10 July 2015, in the Water & Sanitation Boardroom, 3th Floor, Professor Nyembezi Building, 341 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, 3201 Only one compulsory Clarification Meeting will be held. **Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.** An official will chair the meeting and answer queries raised by prospective Tenderers. Any amendment to the tender documentation arising from such answers will be circulated in terms of the meeting's attendance register. **Tenderers must present their tender document at the meeting failing which the Tenderer shall be disqualified.**

Sealed tenders in endorsed on the envelope "**Specialised Contract No. SCM 106 of 14/15**" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Thursday, 16 July 2015**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System. Stage 1 being Functionality and Stage 2 based on the 90/10 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.
