CONSTRUCTION OF DEBRIS NET INCLUDING REMEDIAL WORK TO BRICKWORK AT THE PROFESSOR NYEMBEZI BUILDING, PIETERMARITZBURG

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Tenderers for the above works. Only tenderers with a CIDB Contractor grading of either 2SC/2GB/2CE or higher, who have the relevant expertise, capacity, experience and/or construction equipment shall be eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **12h00 on Monday 16 September 2013**. A non refundable tender fee in the amount **R151.62** (including VAT) per document shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A compulsory Site Inspection meeting will be held at 10h00 prompt on Wednesday, 25 September 2013, on the 2nd Floor Parking Area of the Professor Nyembezi Building, 341 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, 3201. Only one Site Inspection Meeting will be held. Only one (1) Representative per Company will be allowed to attend the meeting. *Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.* An official will chair the meeting and answer queries raised by prospective Tenderers. Any amendment to the tender documentation arising from such answers will be circulated in terms of the meeting's attendance register.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "Specialised Contract No. SCM 25 of 13/14" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, 3201, not later than 12h00 on Friday, 4 October 2013, when they will be opened in public. Only tenders placed in the tender box shall be accepted. Under no circumstances whatsoever will any extension of time be allowed for submission of tenders.

<u>Tender Validity Period</u>: Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

<u>Tender Evaluation Criteria</u>: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System. Stage 1 being Functionality and Stage 2 based on the 80/20 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.

The Msunduzi Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender, and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of a tender. Each tenderer will be informed of the tender result. The Msunduzi Municipality expects businesses within the Pietermaritzburg and Midlands Region to support its contract and BEE/SMME initiatives.
