Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "Contract No. SCM 31 of 11/12" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than 12h00 on Wednesday, 01st February 2012. Only tenders placed in the tender box shall be accepted.

The validity period for which the tender is to hold firm is a period of ninety (90) days from closing date of tender.

Evaluation and adjudication of the tender will be done in line with the Msunduzi Municipality's approved Supply Chain and Preferential Procurement Policies on an 80/20 point system. Adjudication criteria will be as per the tender document; the allocation of points will be done in line with B-BBEE as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No 5 of 2000.

The Msunduzi Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender, and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of a tender. Each tenderer will be informed of the tender result.
