Further to this, all Service Providers attending the meeting must be in possession of a Tender Document failing which the Service Provider shall be disqualified. Only one (1) Representative per Company or Joint Venture or Consortium will be allowed to attend the above meeting. No Service Provider will be allowed to represent more than one (1) Company at the meeting.
