Only one Tender Briefing Meeting will be held. ***Service Providers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.*** An official will chair the meeting and answer queries raised by prospective Service Providers. Any amendment to the tender documentation arising from such answers will be circulated in terms of the meeting's attendance register.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with the relevant Contract No. must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Wednesday, 25 July 2012**, when they will be publically opened. Only tenders placed in the tender box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity period: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of the tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender for the development of the Local Area Plans [**Contract No. SCM 65 of 11/12 & Contract No. SCM 66 of 11/12**] shall be evaluated on the 90/10 Preferential Points System and the extension of the Town Planning Scheme [**Contract No. SCM 67 of 11/12**] shall be evaluated on the 80/20 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.

The Council does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of a tender. Each Service Provider will be informed of the tender result. The Council expects businesses within the Pietermaritzburg and Midlands Region to support its contract and affirmative action programmes.
