Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Tenderers for the above works. Only Contractors with a CIDB Grading of 3GB/3CE or higher, who have the relevant expertise, capacity, experience and/or construction equipment shall be eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **10h00 on Wednesday, 8 April 2015**. A non - refundable tender fee in the amount R401.28 (including VAT) per document shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A compulsory Site Inspection meeting will be held at 10h00 prompt on Thursday, 16 April 2015, at the Sobantu Hall, Sikhosana Street, Sobantu, Pietermaritzburg, 3201, from where all will travel in convoy to site. Only one Site Inspection meeting will be held. An official will chair the meeting and answer queries raised by prospective Tenderers. Any amendment to the tender documentation arising from such answers will be circulated in terms of the meeting's attendance register. ***Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will not be allowed to attend the meeting. Tenderers must present their tender document at the meeting failing which the Tenderer shall be disqualified.***

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "**Specialised Contract No. SCM 91 of 14/15**" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00, on Thursday, 23 April 2015**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on the 90/10 Preferential Points System and in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.
