Tenderers are also required to submit a construction programme for the execution of work. Tenderers will be evaluated according to the specification of the contract.**

Only one Tender Briefing meeting will be held. ***Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.***

Sealed quotation endorsed on the envelope "**SPECIALISED QUOTATION No. Q 72 OF 15/16**" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00, on Monday, 19 October 2015** when it will be publicly opened. Only quotations placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

**The Validity period** shall hold firm for ninety (90) days commencing from closing date of the quotation.
