Thereafter proceed to site. Only one Tender Briefing meeting will be held. *Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified. Please ensure that documents are purchased prior and brought to the tender briefing meeting. Failure to abide by the above will result in the tenderer not being permitted to attend the site inspection meeting.*

Sealed quotation endorsed on the envelope "<u>SPECIALISED QUOTATION No. Q 145 OF 14/15</u>" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00**, on **Tuesday**, **10 February 2015** when it will be publicly opened. Only quotations placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

<u>The Validity period</u> shall hold firm for ninety (90) days commencing from closing date of the quotation.

<u>Tender Adjudication & Evaluation Criteria</u> will be implemented in line with the Msunduzi Municipality's approved Supply Chain and Preferential Procurement Policies on the **80/20** point system. Adjudication criteria will be as per the tender document, the allocation of points will be in line with **B-BBEE** as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 pertaining to the **Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act**, Act No. 5 of 2000.
