Only one Tender Briefing Meeting will be held. Service Providers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified. An official will chair the meeting and answer queries raised by prospective Service Providers. Any amendment to the tender documentation arising from such answers will be circulated in terms of the meeting's attendance register.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "Specialised Quotation No. Q 54 of 11/12" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Thursday, 3 May 2012**. Only tenders placed in the tender box shall be accepted.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on the 80/20 Preferential Points System and in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.
