Only one compulsory Clarification Meeting will be held. ***Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.*** No tender shall be accepted from tenderers who do not attend the above meeting. Tenderers will be required to present their tender document at the Clarification Meeting.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "**Supplies and Services Contract No. E 26 of 2014**" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Tuesday, 14 October 2014**, when they will be opened in public. Only tenders placed in the tender box shall be accepted. Under no circumstances whatsoever will any extension of time be allowed for submission of tenders.

Tender Validity period: Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of the tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on the 90/10 Preferential Points System and in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.

The Council expects businesses within the Pietermaritzburg and Midlands Region to support its contract and affirmative action programmes.
