The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably qualified and experienced Tenderers for the Framework Agreement of Contractors (CIDB Grade 2CE to 8CE) to undertake construction of roads Infrastructure Projects. ***Only Tenderers who have a CIDB grading of 2CE TO 8CE will be considered for appointment.***

Tender documents will be made available to tenderers from **14h00 on Tuesday, 19 August 2025**. Tender documents can be downloaded and printed at the tenderer's cost from the National Treasury eTender Publication Portal on [www.etenders.gov.za](http://www.etenders.gov.za)

Tenders must be submitted both in hard copy and on CD/USB Flash Drive contained in sealed envelopes and marked with “**SCM 11 OF 25/26**” and the **Contract Description** must be placed in the Tender Box located at the Msunduzi Municipality's Central Stores, 2 Abattoir Road (off Kershaw Street), Pietermaritzburg, 3201 (coordinates -29.6126297; 30.3610014), not later than **12h00 on Monday, 22 September 2025**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

**Tender Validity Period:** Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

**Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria:** Tenderers meeting the Mandatory Requirements of the tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – **Stage One:** Functionality and Stage Two: 80/20 Point System in accordance with the Msunduzi Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy (incorporating Preferential Procurement) as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy
