The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites suitable contractor through Open Public Tender for the construction of Madiba Community Hall in Ward 34. Contractors must have a minimum **CIDB Grading of 6 GB or higher to be eligible to tender.**

Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted. Under no circumstances whatsoever will any extension of time be allowed for submission of tenders.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- The tender will be evaluated based on the 80/20 in terms of PPPFA 2022
- The evaluation of tender offers is Method 1: Price and Preference, using the 80/20 preference point system.

Tenderers are to submit a full **Central Supplier Database** (CSD) Report to be eligible to claim the above Specific Goals Preference Points.
