The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from service providers who have the relevant expertise and capacity for the above project for a three (3) year period.

Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication / Evaluation Criteria: The Tenders shall be evaluated on the 80/20 Point System in accordance with the Msunduzi Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy (incorporating Preferential Procurement) as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000.

The allocation of Preference Points will be according to the following Ownership Specific Goals:

Race	At least 51% South African Black Ownership and/or more than 51% management control by South African Black people [Black Owned Enterprise (BOE)].	10
Gender	At least 20% South African Women Ownership.	5
Youth	At least 20% South African Youth Ownership.	5

Verification Method: The tenderer is required to submit a copy of the Company Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) certificate, a FULL Central Supplier Database (CSD) report as well as original certified copies of all Members / Directors / Owners Identity Documents to be eligible to claim the above prescribed Specific Goals Preference Points.
