TENDER NOTICE

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Contractors for the Elimination of Conservancy Tank in Ward 21 for Construction of Approximately 2.7Km of DN160 Sewer Pipeline & Rehabilitation Work.

Only Contractors registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) with a Contractor Grading of 7CE or higher will be eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents will be made available to tenderers from **12h00 on Friday, 19 September 2025**, from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, at a non-refundable tender deposit fee of **R1 327.86 (including VAT)** for each document drawn. Only cash or EFT payments will be accepted. A copy of the Tender Deposit Receipt must be attached to the tender document.

A compulsory **Tender Briefing/Site Inspection** will be held on **Tuesday, 07 October 2025**, at the **Auditorium 1, 1st Floor, Bessie Head Library, 260 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg**, commencing at **10h00**. Thereafter, tenderers shall travel in convoy to site for a Site Inspection. ***Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time above will be disqualified. Tenderers will be required to present their tender document at the meeting to ensure that the Tender Briefing/Site Inspection Certificate is duly signed by the authorised official at the end of the meeting.***

Tenders must be submitted both in hard copy and on CD/USB Flash Drive contained in sealed envelopes and marked with **“SCM 18 OF 25/26 ”** and the **Contract Description** must be placed in the Tender Box located at the Msunduzi Municipality's Central Stores, 2 Abattoir Road (off Kershaw Street), Pietermaritzburg, 3201 (coordinates -29.6126297; 30.3610014), not later than **12h00 on Thursday, 23 October 2025**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: Tenderers meeting the Mandatory Requirements of the tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 80/20 Point System in accordance with the Msunduzi Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy (incorporating Preferential Procurement) as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000, including Chapter 4 of the Public Procurement Act No. 28 of 2024. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:
