Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Contractors for the construction of the Community hall at Edendale CC within ward 22.

Only Contractors registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) with a Contractor Grading of 6GB or higher will be eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents will be made available to tenderers from **14h00 on Wednesday, 28 January 2026**. Tender documents can be downloaded and printed at the tenderer's cost from the National Treasury eTender Publication Portal on www.etenders.gov.za.

Printed copies documents shall also be made available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, as from the above-mentioned date and time, at a non-refundable tender deposit fee of **R1 327.86 (including VAT)** for each document drawn. A compulsory **Tender Briefing/Site Inspection** will be held on **Friday, 13 February 2026**, at the **Auditorium 1, 1st Floor, Bessie Head Library, 260 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg**, commencing at **10h00**. Thereafter, tenderers shall travel in convoy to site for a Site Inspection. ***Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time above will be disqualified. Tenderers will be required to present their tender document at the meeting to ensure that the Tender Briefing/Site Inspection Certificate is duly signed by the authorised official at the end of the meeting.***

Tenders must be submitted both in hard copy and on CD/USB Flash Drive contained in sealed envelopes and marked with “**SCM 33 OF 25/26**” and the **Contract Description** must be placed in the Tender Box located at the Msunduzi Municipality's Central Stores, 2 Abattoir Road (off Kershaw Street), Pietermaritzburg, 3201 (coordinates -29.6126297; 30.3610014), not later than **12h00 on Friday, 27 February 2026**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: Tenderers meeting the Mandatory Requirements of the tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 80/20 Point System in accordance with the Msunduzi Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy (incorporating Preferential Procurement) as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2022, pertaining to the Preferential Procurement Policy

Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000, including Chapter 4 of the Public Procurement Act No. 28 of 2024. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:
