**ROADS TO SURFACE ROADS – CAPITAL AND GRANT FUNDED PROJECTS ONLY**

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Service Providers for construction and upgrading of gravel roads to surface .for the Msunduzi Municipality for a period of 36 months on “as and when” required basis. **CIDB grade of 2CE or higher.**

Tender documents will be available to tenderers from **14h30 on Friday,29<sup>th</sup> January 2021.** Tender documents can be downloaded and printed at the tenderer’s cost from the National Treasury e-Tender Publication Portal on [www.etenders.gov.za](http://www.etenders.gov.za).

Printed copies of the tender documents shall also be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, at a non-refundable tender deposit fee of **R568.10 (including VAT)** for each document drawn. Tenders must be submitted both in **hard copy and on a CD/USB Flash Drive** contained in sealed envelopes and marked with “**Contract No. SCM 37 of 20/21**” and the **Contract Description** must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00, on Thursday, 04<sup>th</sup> March 2021.** Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

**Tender Validity Period:** Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

**Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria:** The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 80/20 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2017, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:

**Threshold for 5CE or higher = 70% or minimum of 87,5 points for bidder to be selected to participate in a close tender process.**

**Threshold for 3CE to 4CE = 50% or minimum of 62,5 points for bidder to be selected to participate in a close tender process.**

**Threshold for 2CE = 30% or minimum of 37,5 points for bidder to be selected to participate in a close tender process.**

The Msunduzi Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of a tender.

Each tenderer will be informed of the tender result. The Msunduzi Municipality expects businesses within the Pietermaritzburg and Midlands Region to support its contract and BEE/SMME initiatives.
