The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from Contractors with a CIDB grading of 6GB or higher for the above construction. Contractors with BBBEE levels 1 or 2 will be considered.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **12h00** on **Tuesday**, **19 October 2021**, at a non-refundable tender deposit fee of **R 997.00 (including VAT)** for each document drawn. Only cash, bank guaranteed cheques or EFT payments will be accepted. **The cut-off time for the purchasing and collection of tender documents shall be 14h00 on Tuesday**, **26 October 2021**. A copy of the Tender Deposit Receipt must be attached to the tender document.

A compulsory Tender Briefing Meeting will be conducted on site commencing promptly at 10h30 on Wednesday, 27 October 2021. The site is accessible via a gravel road (L1875) which branches off from Selby Msimang Road, Tailors Halt in Pietermaritzburg. The co-ordinates of the site are 29°41'38.85"S and 30° 9'29.90"E. Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time above will be excluded. Further, all Tenderers attending the meeting must be in possession of a tender document failing which the Tenderer shall be disqualified. Only one representative per Contracting Company will be allowed to attend the above meeting. All Covid-19 restrictions to be strictly observed.

Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted. Under no circumstances whatsoever will any extension of time be allowed for submission of tenders.

Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

#### **Tender Evaluation Criteria**

The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System. Stage One being Functionality and Stage Two based on the 80/20 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.
