The Municipality will continue to advertise its Tender Notices on the National Treasury e-Tender Portal and Municipal website.

Tenders must be submitted together in hard copy and on a CD/USB Flash Drive contained in sealed envelopes and marked with "<u>SPECIALISED CONTRACT No. SCM 41 OF 21/22</u>" and Description, must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00**, on Wednesday, 23 February 2022, when they will be publicly opened.
