Tenders must be submitted together in hard copy and on a CD/USB Flash Drive contained in sealed envelopes and marked with the "<u>Contract No. E9 OF 2021</u>" and Description, must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00**, on **Tuesday, 31 August 2021**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted. Under no circumstances whatsoever will any extension of time be allowed for submission of tenders.
