PROVISION OF AD-HOC CONSTRUCTION SERVICES FOR MSUNDUZI INTERGRATED RAPID PUBLIC TRANSPORT NETWORK(IRPTN), CIDB GRADING FROM 3CE TO 9CE.

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Contractors to be put on a panel of Contractors on "as and when required" basis for a period of three years.

Only tenderers with B-BBEE Contributor Levels of 1 and 2 will be considered for appointment.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000.
