SUPPLY, INSTALLATION, OPERATION AND MONITORING OF NINE INTEGRATED PERMANENT SEWER FLOW MONITORING STATIONS AND SEVEN RAINFALL STATIONS

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Service Providers for the above works.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **12h00 on Monday, 11 November 2013**. A non - refundable tender fee in the amount **R380.76** (including VAT) per document shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A compulsory Tender Briefing meeting will be held at **10h30 prompt on Wednesday**, **20 November 2013**, in the Water & Sanitation Boardroom, 5th Floor, Professor Nyembezi Building, 341 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, **3201**. Only one Tender Briefing meeting will be held. An official will chair the meeting and answer queries raised by prospective Tenderers. Any amendment to the tender documentation arising from such answers will be circulated in terms of the meeting's attendance register.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "Contract No. SCM 36 of 13/14" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than 12h00, on Wednesday, 27 November 2013, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

<u>Tender Evaluation Criteria</u>: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System. Stage 1 being Functionality and Stage 2 based on the 90/10 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage 1 shall be as follows:-

Company Experience: Installation and commissioning of electronic sewer flow monitoring systems	Max 10 Points
Company Experience: Installation and commissioning of data transmission and display systems	Max 10 Points
Contracts Manager Experience: Supply, installation, operation and monitoring of integrated flow monitoring systems	Max 10 Points
Design Engineer Experience: Instrumentation, Telemetry and/or SCADA	Max 10 Points
Installation Technician/Engineer Experience (Site Agent): Instrumentation, Telemetry and/or SCADA	Max 10 Points
Tenderer's Bank Rating	Max 10 Points
Maximum Points Under Technical Functionality	Max 60 Points

Only Tenderers who score a minimum of 60% and above in Stage 1 shall be considered for Stage 2.

The Msunduzi Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender, and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of a tender.
