No tender shall be accepted from tenderers who do not attend the above meeting.*

Sealed tenders, endorsed on the envelope "**QUOTATION No. SCM Q76 OF 12/13**" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00**, on **Friday, 15 February 2013**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

The Validity period shall hold firm for ninety (90) days commencing from closing date of the tender.

Tender Adjudication & Evaluation Criteria will be implemented in line with the Msunduzi Municipality's approved Supply Chain and Preferential Procurement Policies on the **80/20** point system. Adjudication criteria will be as per the tender document, the allocation of points will be in line with **B-BBEE** as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 pertaining to the **Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act**, Act No. 5 of 2000.
