The site is located along Langalibalele Street, next to the Publicity Building. The entrance into the building is via Market Street, Pietermaritzburg.

A compulsory Tender Briefing meeting will be held at 10h30 prompt on Friday, 23 August 2013, at the Tourism Hub building, Church Street, Pietermaritzburg.. Only one Tender Briefing meeting will be held. *Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.* An official will chair the meeting and answer queries raised by prospective Tenderers. Any amendment to the tender documentation arising from such answers will be circulated in terms of the meeting's attendance register.

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Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "Specialised Contract No. SCM 11 of 13/14" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, 3201, not later than 12h00 on Friday, 6 September 2013, when they will be opened in public. Only tenders placed in the tender box shall be accepted. Under no circumstances whatsoever will any extension of time be allowed for submission of tenders.

Tender Validity Period: Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

<u>Tender Evaluation Criteria</u>: The tender shall be evaluated on the 90/10 Preferential Points System and in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.

The Msunduzi Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender, and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of a tender. Each tenderer will be informed of the tender result. The Msunduzi Municipality expects businesses within the Pietermaritzburg and Midlands Region to support its contract and BEE/SMME initiatives.
