No tender shall be accepted from tenderers who do not attend the above meeting. Tenderers must present their tender document at the above Meeting.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with the relevant Contract No. and Section must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00**, on **Thursday, 21 January 2016**, when they will be publicly opened.
