Tenderers shall be required to meet on the date and time mentioned above at the Churchill Fountain situated at the corner of Church Street and Bank Street (opposite the Standard Bank), Pietermaritzburg, 3201. Only one compulsory Clarification Meeting will be held. *Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.* An official will chair the meeting and answer queries raised by prospective Tenderers. Any amendment to the tender documentation arising from such answers will be circulated in terms of the meeting's attendance register. *Tenderers must present their tender document at the meeting failing which the Tenderer shall be disqualified.*

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "Supplies & Services Contract No. 70 of 2015" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than 12h00 on Tuesday, 18 August 2015, when they will be opened in public.
