MECHANICAL AND REFRIGERATION CONTRACT FOR THE MSUNDUZI MARKET, PIETERMARITZBURG

The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably qualified and experienced Contractors for the above works.

Only Contractors registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) with a Contractor Grading of 1ME and/or 1EB, or higher, shall be eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **12h00 on Monday, 24 August 2015**. A non - refundable tender fee in the amount **R425.22 (including VAT) per document** shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A compulsory Tender Briefing Meeting will be held on **Monday, 31 August 2015**, in the **Msunduzi Market Boardroom, 01 Market Road, Mkondeni, Pietermaritzburg**, commencing promptly at **10h30**, followed by a Site Inspection of the Msunduzi Market. Only one Tender Briefing Meeting and Site Inspection will be held. **Note: Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time above will be disqualified.**

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with “**Supply and Services Contract No. 56 of 2015**” and the Contract Description, must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Monday, 21 September 2015**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-

1	Number of successfully completed projects/contracts related to installation/refurbishment/modification and/or maintenance of mechanical and refrigeration plants successfully completed.	20 Points
2	Total number of years that the Site Agent/Senior Technician/Engineer has in terms of similar work experience on mechanical and refrigeration plants.	20 Points
3	Locality of Company	20 Points
Total Functionality Points		60 Points
Threshold to qualify for Stage Two		60% (36 Points)
