## **UPGRADING OF SELBY MSIMANGO ROAD FROM KM 5.5 TO KM 6.5**

The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably qualified and experienced Contractors for the upgrading, widening and re-alignment of Selby Msimango Road from Km 5.5 to Km 6.5.

Only Contractors registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) with a Contractor Grading of 8CE, or higher, shall be eligible to submit tenders.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **12h00** on **Thursday, 03 September 2015**. A non - refundable tender fee in the amount **R707.94** (including VAT) per document shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A compulsory Tender Clarification Meeting will be held prompt at 10h30, on Monday 14 September 2015, at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Boardroom, Harry Gwala Stadium, Princess Margaret Drive, Scottsville, Pietermaritzburg, from where all will thereafter travel in convoy to site. Only one Tender Clarification Meeting and Site Inspection will be held. Note: Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time above will be disqualified.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with "Contract No. SCM 9 of 15/16: Upgrading of Selby Msimango Road from Km 5.5 to Km 6.5" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than 12h00 on Monday, 28 September 2015, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

<u>Tender Validity Period</u>: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

<u>Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria</u>: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-
