PROVISION OF AD-HOC PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE MSUNDUZI INTEGRATED RAPID PUBLIC TRANSPORT NETWORK (IRPTN) PROJECT

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Engineering Consultants for the Provision of Ad-Hoc Professional Engineering Services for the Msunduzi Integrated Rapid Public Transport Network (IRPTN) Project, on an "as and when" required basis for a period of three years.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **12h00** on **Tuesday**, **15 September 2015**. A non - refundable tender fee in the amount of **R425.22 (including VAT) per document** shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with "Contract No. SCM 16 of 15/16" and the Contract Description must be placed in the Tender Box, located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than 12h00 on Monday, 05 October 2015, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of the tender.

Tender Evaluation Criteria: The tenders shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-
