PROVISION OF AD-HOC PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE MSUNDUZI INTEGRATED RAPID PUBLIC TRANSPORT NETWORK (IRPTN) PROJECT

Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Engineering Consultants for the Provision of Ad-Hoc Professional Engineering Services for the Msunduzi Integrated Rapid Public Transport Network (IRPTN) Project, on an “as and when” required basis for a period of three years.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **12h00 on Tuesday, 15 September 2015**. A non - refundable tender fee in the amount of **R425.22 (including VAT) per document** shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with “**Contract No. SCM 16 of 15/16**” and the Contract Description must be placed in the Tender Box, located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Monday, 05 October 2015**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of the tender.

Tender Evaluation Criteria: The tenders shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-
