<u>Tender Validity Period</u>: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tenders shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 80/20 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000.
