Tenders are hereby invited from suitably qualified and experienced Service Providers for the Provision of Ad-Hoc Professional Planning and Development Services to be listed onto the Msunduzi Municipality's Supply Chain Management Database for projects exceeding one million rand (>R1,000,000.00) on an "as and when required" basis for a period of three years.

The scope of work which the panel of Service Providers will engage with, will include but not be limited to the following:-

A non - refundable tender fee in the amount of **R 425.22 (including VAT) per document** shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A compulsory Tender Briefing Meeting will be held prompt at 10h30, on Wednesday 17 February 2016, in the Transportation Boardroom, 5th Floor, A. S. Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg. Only one Tender Briefing Meeting will be held. *Note: Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time above will be disqualified*.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope with "Contract No. SCM 31 of 15/16: Provision of Ad-Hoc Professional Planning and Development Services for Projects Exceeding One Million Rand" must be placed in the Tender Box, located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than 12h00 on Thursday, 25 February 2016, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

<u>Tender Validity Period</u>: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of the tender.

<u>Tender Evaluation Criteria</u>: The tenders shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-
