CONTRACT No. SCM 41 OF 15/16

UPGRADING OF MT PARTRIDGE ROAD

The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably qualified and experienced Contractors for the above work. *Only Service Providers with a CIDB grading of 6CE or Higher will be considered*.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **14h00** on **Thursday, 24 March 2016**. A non - refundable tender fee in the amount **R 707.94 (including VAT) per document** shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A compulsory Tender Briefing/Site Meeting will take place on Monday, 4 April 2016. Prospective tenderers shall meet promptly at 10h00 at the service road under the Rail-Over-Road Bridge approximately 400m south of the Hulamin/Afrox traffic signal intersection in Moses Mabhida Road (Edendale Road), from where all will travel in convey to site. Only one compulsory Clarification Meeting will be held. No tender shall be accepted from tenderers who do not attend the above meeting. Tenderers will be required to present their tender document at the Meeting. *Note: Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time above will be disqualified*.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "<u>Contract No. SCM 41 of 15/16</u>" and the Contract Description must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00**, on **Thursday**, **14 April 2016**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

<u>Tender Validity Period</u>: Three (3) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One: Functionality and Stage Two: 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000.
