The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites suitably qualified and experienced Service Providers to tender for the above works.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A S Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **14h00** on **Tuesday**, **17 May 2016**. A non-refundable tender fee in the amount **R 425.22** (including VAT) per document shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "<u>Contract No. SCM 47 of 15/16</u>" and the Contract Description must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00** on **Thursday**, **2 June 2016**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System. Stage 1 being Functionality and Stage 2 based on the 90/10 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.

The Functionality for Stage 1 shall be as follows:-
