Only one compulsory Clarification Meeting will be held. **Note: Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.** No tender shall be accepted from tenderers who do not attend the above meeting. Tenderers will be required to present their tender document at the Clarification Meeting.

Tender Validity Period: Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

<u>Tender Evaluation Criteria</u>: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System. Stage 1 being Functionality and Stage 2 based on the 90/10 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.
