Only tenderers with a CIDB Contractor grading of 3EB or higher and Electrical Contractors Board/Electrical Contractors Association, who have the relevant expertise, capacity and experience, shall be eligible to submit tenders.

Only one compulsory Clarification Meeting will be held. *Note: Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will be disqualified.* No tender shall be accepted from tenderers who do not attend the above meeting. Tenderers will be required to present their tender document at the Clarification Meeting.

Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

Tender Validity Period: Ninety (90) days commencing from the closing date of tender.

Tender Evaluation Criteria: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System. Stage 1 being Functionality and Stage 2 based on the 90/10 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.
