Only tenders placed in the tender box shall be accepted. Under no circumstances whatsoever will any extension of time be allowed for submission of tenders.

**Tender Validity period:** Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of the tender.

**Tender Adjudication and Evaluation Criteria:** The tender shall be evaluated on the 90/10 Preference Points System and in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2011, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The adjudication criteria will be as per the tender document.
