Not to buy stolen school material/ equipment.

Ward Councillors to support farm schools in dealing with section 14 Agreement issues and farmers/ land owners who do not want to enter into Section 14 lease agreements

Additional funding from National for schools infrastructure needs.

Thorough screening of Contractors /service provider before appointments.

DOPW Supply Chain to speed up documentation, appointing and awarding processes.

Each school must have its own School self maintenance Programme
