The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders for the above works for a three (3) year period. **Only tenderers with a CIDB Contractor grading of 2EP or higher, who have the relevant expertise, capacity, experience and/or equipment, shall be eligible to submit tenders.**

A non-refundable tender fee in the amount **R450.30 (Inc. VAT) per document shall be levied**. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope “**SUPPLY AND SERVICES CONTRACT No. E38 OF 2017**” with the Contract Description must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street (Commercial Road), Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00, on Thursday, 19 January 2017**, when they will be publicly opened. Only tenders placed in the Tender Box shall be accepted.

**Tender Validity Period:** Four (4) months commencing from the closing date of tender.

**Tender Evaluation Criteria:** The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System. Stage 1 being Functionality and Stage 2 based on the 90/10 Preferential Points System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011 issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No. 5 of 2000.
