The Municipality has a programme for restoring power to these areas. There are challenges that as a municipality we are experiencing and that is leading to the low voltage and lack of electricity in some areas. As the municipality we cannot run away from the fact that there are illegal connections that are leading to a high unexpected load. There are also elements of sabotage that are being investigated at the moment. We have a team that is working around the clock to ensure that stability and services are being rendered to our consumers. Any inconvenience caused is regrettable.
