Only one Tender Briefing Meeting will be held for the above contract. Tenderers arriving at the meeting after the stipulated starting time mentioned above will be disqualified. Further to this, all Tenderers attending the meeting must be in possession of a Tender Document failing which the Service Provider shall be disqualified. Only one (1) Representative per Company or Joint Venture or Consortium will be allowed to attend the above meeting. No Tenderer will be allowed to represent more than one (1) Company at the meeting.

<u>Tender Adjudication/Evaluation Criteria</u>: The tender shall be evaluated on a Two Stage Evaluation System – Stage One being Functionality and Stage Two being either the 80/20 or 90/10 Preference Point System in accordance with the Preferential Procurement

Regulations, 2017, issued in terms of section 5 of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, Act No. 5 of 2000. The Functionality for Stage One shall be evaluated on the following criteria:-
