The Msunduzi Municipality hereby invites tenders from suitably qualified and experienced Metal Fabricators for the repairs and installation of a catwalk structure, support beams and covers at the Sobantu Sewer Pump Station, situated in the suburb of Sobantu, Pietermaritzburg.

Tender documents shall be available from the Supply Chain Management Unit Offices, 5th Floor, A. S. Chetty Centre, 333 Church Street, Pietermaritzburg, from **Wednesday, 12 October 2011**. A non- refundable tender fee in the amount **R114.00** per document shall be levied. Only cash or bank guaranteed cheques will be accepted.

A **compulsory Site Inspection Meeting** will be held on site on **Friday, 14 October 2011**. Prospective tenderers shall meet at the cul-de-sac of Grix Road, Sobantu, Pietermaritzburg, promptly at 10h00, and thereafter proceed in convoy to the Sobantu Pump Station. Only one Site Inspection Meeting will be held. No tender shall be accepted from tenderers who do not attend the above meeting. No tender documents shall be issued at the Site Inspection Meeting. ***Tenderers who arrive at the meeting after the stipulated starting time will not be allowed to tender.***

Sealed tenders endorsed on the envelope "**Quotation No. SCM Q19 of 11/12**" must be placed in the Tender Box located in the Foyer, Ground Floor, City Hall, 169 Chief Albert Luthuli Street, Pietermaritzburg, not later than **12h00 on Wednesday, 19 October 2011**. Only tenders placed in the tender box shall be accepted.

The validity period for which the tender is to hold firm is a period of **ninety (90) days** from closing date of tender.

Evaluation and adjudication of the tender will be done in line with the Msunduzi Municipality's approved Supply Chain and Preferential Procurement Policies on the **80/20 point system**.

The Msunduzi Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest or any tender, and reserves the right to accept the whole or any part of a tender. Each tenderer will be informed of the tender result.
